- NRM -Request for proposals –(3 year cycles).
- Numerous Categories.
- Alien Invasive Plants, Bush Encroachment and Sustainable Forestry Projects, including Ecosystem Monitoring and the wise-use of natural resources.
- Successful applicants – submit plans of operation (APO), hectares, bodies, cost per person day.
- Budget Allocation Western Cape divided between service providers. (R80m)
- If accepted appointed on Department Forestry Fisheries and the environments (DFFE) data base MOA.
